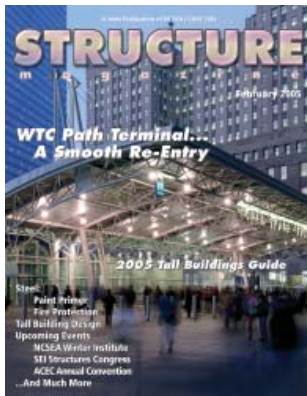

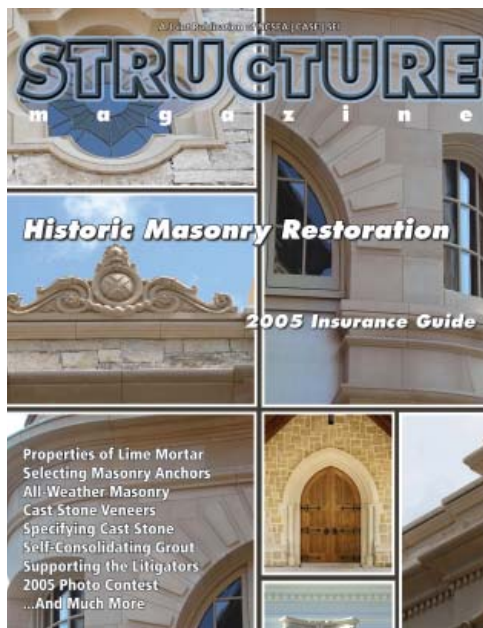

MECHANICAL SPECIFICATIONS

Words and pictures can work together to communicate more powerfully than either alone *~ William Albert Allard*

Submitted images should follow mechanical specifications noted below.



Copper Creek, Publisher, will scan standard photographs, and provide minor retouch services. However, if scanned and/or retouched image is deemed to be not acceptable for printing, the photographer will be notified.

Digital photographs are acceptable and may be submitted electronically via e-mail, uploaded to our FTP Site or submitted on DVD or CD-ROM storage mediums. Although MAC files are acceptable, all storage media must be formatted for use on a PC.

Each photograph must be as physically large as possible with a minimum 300 DPI resolution. Each photograph must be submitted as an **individual file** formatted as a JPEG, TIF, EPS, PICT, or PDF. For a cover shot, the image must be a minimum of 9" w x 12" h at 300 DPI.

Do not send GIF photos, or send images in word documents. These images **cannot** be used for final print production. These low-resolution formats work well on the Internet for viewing on a monitor, but they do not yield the high quality necessary for printing. If your photograph was prepared digitally (i.e. with a digital camera or as a screen shot), please use the **highest possible** resolution setting (300 dpi or greater) TIF setting. Don't bother changing a low-resolution JPEG or GIF to a TIF as it will retain the low resolution when printed. Low resolution electronic artwork and photos **will not** be printed.

Printed photographs are best sent as hard copy for scanning by Copper Creek. Photos may consist of 35 mm, 2 1/4"x2 1/4", 4"x5" or 8"x10" transparencies. All reflective artwork must be bendable and suitable for scanning or will be subject to charge for conversion of transparency.
