
Introduction:




Fig. 371-c. White Concrete Long Span Flat Floor Arch, System D.






Fig. 4 Concrete Steel ("Cantilever") System (4-Way)






Fig. 510. Johnson Bar. Corrugated Squares. Old Style.





Fig. 258. Typical Terra-cotta Cornices for Skeleton Construction.
